#### PRESIDENTS REPORT

"Pray the rosary everyday to obtain peace for the world", were the instructions that the Blessed Mother gave to the children at Fatima. (From A Pathway Under The gaze of Mary, the biography of Sister Lucia of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of May) Our Holy Name Union has adhered to those instructions for 71 years with our daily broadcast of the radio rosary. As is our tradition, we will pray the rosary live from St. Rita at the Annual Rosary Congress on Tuesday, October 10, 2017. I ask that every Holy Name Society member who is able, join us for the radio rosary as this centennial year of the Apparitions at Fatima comes to a close. Our praying of the rosary as a Holy Name Union exemplifies our devotion to the name of Jesus through the Immaculate Heart of Mary and recognizes our commitment to spread the devotion. This also raises awareness of the Holy Name Society that may encourage others to join.

On another note; I recently had an opportunity to participate in the National Association of Holy Name Societies Regional Vice Presidents' teleconference. One of the concerns presented was the nationwide decline in Holy Name Society membership. The common contributing factors are aging membership and the increasing number of parish men's clubs. One of the Spiritual Moderators called for an emphasis on the spiritual and corporal works of mercy as one way of increasing membership. This approach may prove to be a viable strategy to recruit new and younger members. By doing so, we provide focus and purpose toward accomplishing tangible goals which is tantamount to getting today's young people involved. Studies show that our young people are more apt to join an organization that gives them a sense purpose and accomplishment while also providing a feeling of belonging to something bigger than themselves. We can and should seek opportunities that are welcoming as well as inclusive of younger catholics that will generate and interest leading to membership in the Holy Name Society. Therefore, I ask that we share success stories, best practices that have resulted in recruiting new members within parish societies. Please email your stories to me at salubrious 1978@aol.com.
