WVOG – 600 AM LIVE RADIO ROSARY BROADCAST

The live Radio Rosary broadcast will continue every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 6:00 pm.

There are new procedures for calling in for the live radio Rosary broadcast. I have emailed copies of the procedure to all HNS Society parishes.

Please read over the procedure and if you have any questions please call Anthony Smith at 504-481-3407.

RADIO ROSARY PROCEDURE

The live broadcast will be on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

New call-in number – 504-831-2647

It is important that you call in by 5:55 pm

You will know you are connected when you hear the program prior to ours playing or you hear the opening of our Rosary broadcast.

(If you hear a busy signal or dial tone it didn't connect, hang up and call the number again). When you hear our announcement, welcome to the live Rosary broadcast, you will be live on the air and anything you say can be heard over the air. Please be mindful of that.

Please begin the Rosary when you hear the announcement (the Rosary will begin now).

You will have 27.26 minutes to complete the Rosary and the Holy Name closing prayers.

If you finish in less than 27.26 minutes you can continue with any prayers you want to add (this will be helpful in filling in dead air time) and continue praying until you hear the song, Let their be Peace on Earth, at that time you are no longer on the air and you will no longer be hear.

VERY IMPORTANT!! Because of this new procedure you will not be talking to a person anymore. The entire process will be computerized and because of this new procedure, THERE WILL NOT BE ANYONE AT THE STATION to play the tape if you don't keep your assignment.

WVOG MUST HAVE 48 hours' notice if you are unable to keep your assigned night, OTHERWISE THERE WILL BE NO WAY TO START THE TAPED RECORDING AND THERE WILL BE 30 MINUTES WITH NO PROGRAMMING WHICH IS AGAINST FCC RULES AND COULD CAUSE A PROBLEM FOR WVOG.

If you cannot give WVOG 48 hours' notice someone from your parish MUST BE AVAILABLE TO KEEP YOUR ASSIGNED NIGHT.
